# **Engineering Education Enhancement (\$1,200)**

**Project:** Introduce a hands-on engineering experience to grades 5-8 to enhance the science and mathematics curriculum and introduce students to future career opportunities.

## Mass Communication Course with Video Announcements & Production (\$5,541)

**Project:** Study & practice the elements of mass communication, with emphasis on creation, production and publication of news and other information through television and/or radio.

### **TIG Welder** (\$3,500)

Ryan Volke, Tech Education Teacher - Port Washington High School

**Project**: The Aluminum TIG welder will provide exposure to another welding process for those students interested in welding as a career, and strengthen partnerships with the school district's manufacturing and other S.T.E.A.M. partners.

## SES Summer Boost (\$2,500)

Danielle Brown, School Psychologist -SES

**Project:** Reduce academic summer backslide by providing intensive specific skill support to low performing students at each grade level. Project timeline is July 14-August 20 and will involve parent partnerships and motivational hands-on activities.

**Project:** Provided exposure to animation software and technology for students to learn how to turn their artwork and ideas into animation video.

# 7th Grade Communications Classroom Libraries (\$2,000)

**Project:** Classroom libraries enhanced with fiction and non-fiction reading material related to the social studies and science curricula. Book-rich classrooms strengthened student's motivation and achievement.
